Scripture Reading: 1 PETER 1:3-5

J SLIDES 1-6. Bible Jeopardy!

- Today is Resurrection Sunday. It's the day Christians around the world celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Every year these same Christians go to their church and hear the message of the death of Jesus Christ, crucified on the cross on Good Friday, followed by the good news message of His resurrection on Sunday morning. Death has no power over our Savior. Death cannot hold our Savior.
- For the true believer, the death of Jesus Christ is for the forgiveness of their sins. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is to pave the way for the true believer unto glory. If Christ was raised unto glory, the believer will also be raised unto glory.
- SLIDE 7. What does this good news mean? The apostle Peter answered that question this way. 1 PETER 1:3-5. BGCC, the worst thing that could ever happen to a human being will never happen to the true believer.
- That was Peter's response. So I ask. What does this good news mean to you? To me? How have our lives changed? It is only through the resurrection of Jesus Christ that any of us can have any kind of hope for our eternity.
- SLIDE 8. 1 PETER 3:14-16. There are always going to be people outside of Christianity who will challenge us because of our faith. We know that. But not here. Not today. Not this Resurrection Sunday. Today is a time for encouragement.
- So, what is your defense for the hope you have? Have the congregation give a testimony for the hope that they have.
